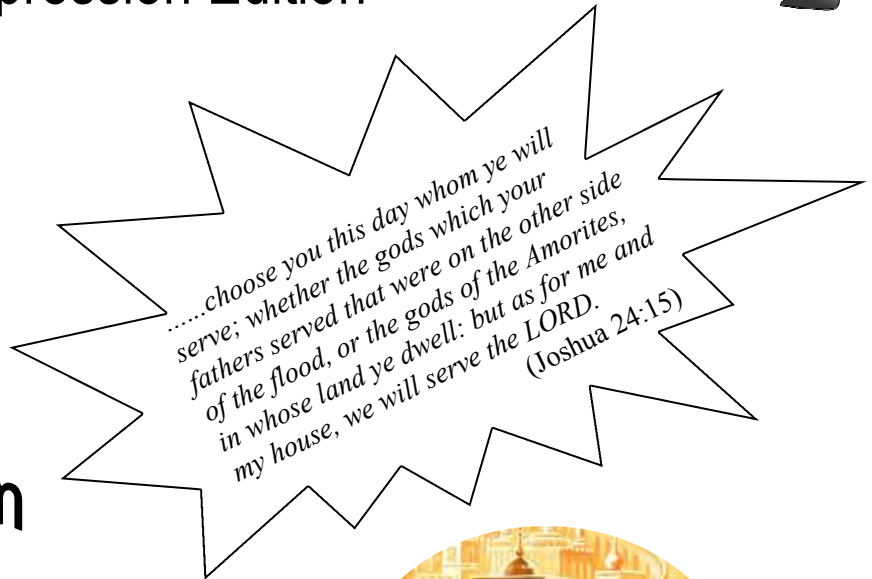

The following are excerpts of the most significant facts about our failing economy (not all 50 from the original article are listed here). *The Sackcloth Times* added scripture references and/or comments to some for emphasis.

- There are over 44 million people on food stamps, and one out of every four American children is on food stamps. (Numbers 14:18b; Jeremiah 17:5)
- Back in 1965, only one out of every 50 Americans was on Medicaid. Today, one out of every 6 Americans is on Medicaid. (Deuteronomy 28:18; Mark 5:26)
- Only 66.8% of American men had a job last year. That was the lowest level that has ever been recorded in all of U.S. history. (Proverbs 6:10,11)
- The United States has lost an average of 50,000 manufacturing jobs per month since China joined the World Trade Organization in 2001, and the U.S. trade deficit with China is now 27 times larger than it was back in 1990. (Deuteronomy 28:33, 36, 48)
- In 2010, the number one U.S. export to China was “scrap and trash.” (Deuteronomy 28:33)
- In the city of Detroit today, there are over 33,000 abandoned houses, 70 schools are being permanently closed down, the mayor wants to bulldoze one-fourth of the city and you can literally buy a house for one dollar in the worst areas. (Joel 1:4)
- New home sales in the United States are now down 80% from the peak in July 2005. (Joel 1:10)
- U.S. home prices have now fallen a whopping 33% from where they were at during the peak of the housing bubble. (Haggai 1:6)
- The average CEO made 343 times more money than the average American did last year, according to a new report from the AFL-CIO. (Proverbs 29:2; Luke 18:25; Jude 1:11)

- The wealthiest 1% of all Americans now own more than a third of all the wealth in the United States, whereas the poorest 50% of all Americans

collectively own just 2.5% of all the wealth in the United States. (Ecclesiastes 4:6; Luke 18:25)

- The percentage of millionaires in Congress is more than 50 times higher than the percentage of millionaires in the general population. (Isaiah 56:11; Psalm 73:1-20; Proverbs 29:2; Ecclesiastes 4:6)

**CHINA OFFICIAL: IT'S TOO LATE,
U.S. ALREADY "DEFAULTING"

As lawmakers scramble to cut a budget deal and avoid defaulting on U.S. debt, the head of a top Chinese rating agency claims it's too late.

Guan Jianzhong, president of Dagong Global Credit Rating Co. Ltd., reportedly told state media that the United States has already defaulted by letting the U.S. dollar weaken.

"In our opinion, the United States has already been defaulting," Guan was quoted as saying, according to AFP.

China, likewise, has long come under criticism for allowing its currency to weaken. But while Dagong Global is known for being tough on the U.S., Guan's words carry extra sting as they follow warnings from three top rating agencies about U.S. finances.

Fitch is the latest to warn the U.S. that its sterling credit rating could be at risk if it fails to raise its \$14.3 trillion debt ceiling or fails to rein in its long-term deficits.

Moody's and Standard & Poor's have already issued similar warnings.

Meanwhile, lawmakers and White House officials are stepping up the pace of budget negotiations as they try to reach a deal that will persuade Congress to lift the debt ceiling by Aug. 2 -- the deadline Treasury Secretary Tim Geithner has given lawmakers. After that date, Geithner warns, he would run out of ways to avoid a devastating default on U.S. obligations.

Some Republicans, while wanting to avoid default, claim the administration could extend that deadline further by making severe and immediate spending cuts elsewhere.

**600 DEAD PENGUINS PRESENT URUGUAY
AUTHORITIES WITH A MYSTERY

Authorities in Uruguay say that about 600 dead penguins have washed up on the Atlantic coast since Saturday. Experts are trying to determine what has killed the animals.

A navy statement Tuesday says the latest batch is 200 dead Magellan penguins discovered on the shore at La Paloma about 125 miles (200 kilometers) east of Montevideo.

A marine animal rescue group previously reported that the carcasses of 400 Magellan penguins washed up around the resort town of Piriapolis, along with dead turtles, dolphins and albatrosses.

The resort is about halfway between Montevideo and La Paloma.

Experts say it is common for dead penguins to appear in the area at this time of year, but the extent of the die-off appears to be unusual.

**NEARLY 3,000 DEAD BIRDS FALL
FROM ARKANSAS SKY

BEEBE, Arkansas – Wildlife experts are trying to solve an apocalyptic-type mystery: Why did nearly 3,000 red-winged blackbirds tumble from the Arkansas sky on New Year's Eve?

The Arkansas Game and Fish Commission spokesman Keith Stephens says the birds fell in an area about a mile long and a half-mile wide (1 1/2 kilometers long and 800 meters wide). The Commission said Saturday that it began receiving reports about the dead birds about 11:30 p.m. the previous night.

The birds fell over a 1-mile (2-kilometer) area, and an aerial survey indicated that no other dead birds were found outside of that area. Laboratories in Arkansas, Georgia and Wisconsin will examine some carcasses starting Monday. Results could be back in a week.

Commission ornithologist Karen Rowe said the birds showed physical trauma, and she speculated that "the flock could have been hit by lightning or

high-altitude hail.”

The commission also speculated that New Year’s Eve revelers shooting off fireworks in the area could have startled the birds from their roost and caused them to die from stress.

Rowe said that similar events have occurred elsewhere and that test results “usually were inconclusive.” She said she doubted the birds were poisoned.

It’s not the first time birds have dropped from the Arkansas sky. Lightning killed ducks at Hot Springs in 2001 and hail knocked birds from the sky at Stuttgart in 1973 on the day before hunting season.

HUGE ARIZONA WILDFIRE SPREADS, HEALTH CONDITIONS WORSEN Associated Press, June 11, 2011

Smoke from a massive wildfire in eastern Arizona that has claimed more than 30 homes and forced nearly 10,000 people to flee has officials worried about serious health impacts to residents and firefighters as tiny particles of soot in the air reached “astronomical” levels.

“It was off the charts,” Mark Shaffer of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality said Friday night.

Calmer winds helped firefighters gain some ground, but also concentrated the sooty air, keeping it stagnate and raising pollution to levels officials hadn’t seen yet since the blaze began several weeks ago.

“We’ve got a serious potential health problem on our hands,” Shaffer said. “When you get levels like this, it’s off the map.”

Officials planned to bring in additional air quality monitoring equipment over the weekend, but warned people to just stay away.

Meanwhile, the blaze was poised to move into New Mexico on Saturday pushed by stronger winds, threatening more towns and possibly endangering two major power lines that bring electricity from Arizona

to West Texas.

The fire has burned 639 square miles of forest, an increase of 114 square miles from a day earlier, officials said.

DEADLY FUNGAL INFECTION STRIKES VICTIMS OF JOPLIN TORNADO Reuters News, June 10, 2011

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Health officials say flying debris from the tornado that tore through Joplin, Missouri, last month is to blame for an outbreak of a rare but serious — and in some cases deadly — fungal infection among some of the more than 900 people injured in the disaster.

Soil or plant matter on debris that penetrated the skin of some of the people who survived the twister is believed to have caused them to contract an infection called zygomycosis, said Uwe Schmidt, an infectious diseases physician at Freeman Health System in Joplin.

Schmidt said he knows of at least nine patients who have had the infection in the weeks since the disaster. Three or four of them died and he said zygomycosis was a factor, if not the actual cause. “It’s definitely quite striking,” Schmidt told Reuters. “To have so many cases of this is rather rare.” He said he had previously only seen two cases of zygomycosis in his career.

The May 22 tornado cut a six-mile swath through Joplin, killing 151 people while destroying some 6,000 homes and many other buildings.

E COLI OUTBREAK OVERWHELMS GERMAN HOSPITALS Associated Press, June 5, 2011

BERLIN -- Hospitals in northern Germany are being

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overwhelmed as they struggle to provide enough beds and medical care for patients stricken by an outbreak of E. coli, the German health minister admitted Sunday.

“The situation in the hospitals is intense,” minister Daniel Bahr told the Bild am Sonntag newspaper, adding that clinics outside of Hamburg and northern Germany -- the epicenter of the E.coli outbreak -- should start taking in ill persons from the north.

Bahr announced he would visit the University Medical Center in Hamburg-Eppendorf later Sunday to see the situation firsthand and talk to physicians and nurses who have been working overtime and double shifts for weeks in a row.

Hamburg is the epicenter of the deadliest E. coli outbreak in modern history, which has killed at least 18 people since May 2. More than 1,700 people in Germany have been infected, including 520 suffering from a life-threatening complication that can cause kidney failure. Ten other European nations and the U.S. have reported 90 other cases, all but two related to visits in northern Germany.

A “TAIL” OF RECORD HEAT

How can a relatively small increase in the average temperature of the planet lead to numerous record-breaking heat waves?

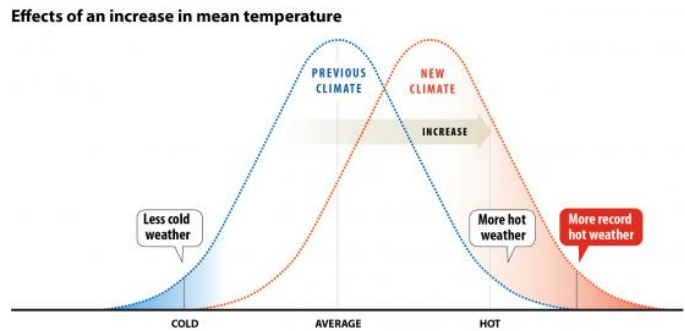
The increase in average global temperatures—about 1.3° Fahrenheit since the mid-19th century—certainly doesn’t sound dramatic. Yet, the impact on extreme temperatures is clear: record high daily temperatures in the United States are outpacing record low daily temperatures by a ratio of 2 to 1.

And the situation overseas is even more telling, with unprecedented heat waves and widespread wildfires last summer across much of Asia (temperatures reached 128°F in Pakistan) and Australia (Perth endured a record number of days in the mid-80s or above). The anomalously high temperatures aren’t just a summertime phenomenon. Canada experienced its warmest winter on record in 2009

and 2010.

Part of the reason for the extreme warmth, at least from a statistical viewpoint, can be gleaned from this graph. The two curves illustrate how a minor increase in average temperatures can have a much greater impact at the edges, or “tails,” of the curve.

As this graphic indicates, a small shift in average temperatures can result in a significant number of record heat events. (©UCAR. This image is freely available for media use.)



“A relatively small shift in the average produces a large change in extremes,” explains NCAR scientist Jerry Meehl, who created an earlier version of the graphic. “If you shift the whole distribution a little to the right you have more extreme heat. The tail on the far right moves into uncharted territory, breaking new heat records.”

The situation is somewhat analogous to the increasing number of elderly people in the United States. There, too, a small change in the average has created a larger impact on the extremes. While average U.S. life expectancy has increased by a moderate amount over the last 50 years—from almost 70 to almost 78—the number of people living to 85 or older has increased more than fivefold.

Hurricane Adrian put on an impressive bout of
 rapid intensification Thursday, intensifying into the
 season's first major hurricane in the Eastern Pacific.

**HAITIAN FLOODING KILLS 23,
 AT LEAST 6 MISSING

The death toll from flooding and landslides after
 torrential rains hit Haiti earlier this week climbed to
 23 Wednesday, the country's civil protection depart-
 ment said.

Floodwaters from the rains swept through homes,
 tent cities and medical facilities, a report from the
 U.N. Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian
 Affairs said.

Dozens of camps were flooded, hundreds of fami-
 lies were affected and at least six people were reported
 missing after the rains, which began Monday evening
 and stretched into Tuesday morning, the report said.

The rainfall has forced residents to evacuate from

tornadoes as we've already had this year," says Dr. Forbes.

**RUSSIAN HEAT WAVE KILLS 5,000
AS FIRES RAGE OUT OF CONTROL**

Russia's devastating summer heat wave has cost almost 5,000 lives, according to officials who conceded yesterday that the state was struggling to gain control over the worst wildfires in decades.

The ministry for emergencies issued an urgent call for volunteers to join fire brigades to bolster the fight against the peat and forest fires raging out of control around Moscow.

Temperatures in Russia have hit records for the time of year on at least six occasions in recent weeks. Forecasters said there would be no respite from temperatures above 97F (36C) for at least another week.

Death rates have escalated steadily since the heat wave began, according to statisticians. "We recorded 14,340 deaths in Moscow in July, that is 4,824 deaths more than in July, 2009," said Yevgenia Smirnova, an official from the Moscow registry office.

Firemen are battling to stop the flames encroaching on the capital. Moscow's landmarks, including the Kremlin and St Basil's Cathedral, were shrouded in a thick, acrid haze. Those workers not ordered to stay at home wore masks as they struggled through the streets.

**BRITAIN PLANNING TO ALLOW
SAME-SEX UNIONS IN CHURCHES**

LONDON -- The British government said Sunday it was planning to change the law and allow same-sex couples to have civil partnership ceremonies in places of worship.

The Sunday Telegraph newspaper said such ceremonies could be permitted to include religious elements for the first time.

The proposed marriage law reforms could also end the legal definition of marriage pertaining only to a man and a woman, in a highly symbolic move, according to London's The Sunday Times.

"The government is currently considering what the next stage should be for civil partnerships, including how some religious organizations can allow same-sex couples to register their relationship in a religious setting if they wish to do so," a Home Office spokesman said.

"Ministers have met a range of people and organizations to hear their views on this issue. An announcement will be made in due course," he said.

**1 IN 3 EMPLOYERS WILL DROP
HEALTH BENEFITS AFTER OBAMACARE
KICKS IN, SURVEY FINDS**

Thirty percent of employers will definitely or probably stop offering health benefits to their employees once the main provisions of President Obama's federal health care law go into effect in 2014, a new survey finds.

The research published in the McKinsey Quarterly found that the number rises to 50 percent among employers who are highly aware of the health care law.

McKinsey and Company, which identifies itself as a management consultant that aims to help businesses run more productively and competitively, conducted the survey of more than 1,300 employers earlier this year. It said the survey spanned industries, geographies and employer sizes.

The research found that contrary to what many employers feared, most employees -- more than 85

percent -- would stay at jobs that no longer offered health benefits. But 60 percent of employees would expect higher compensation.

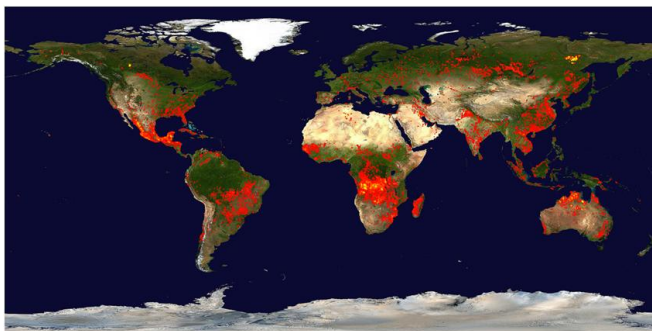

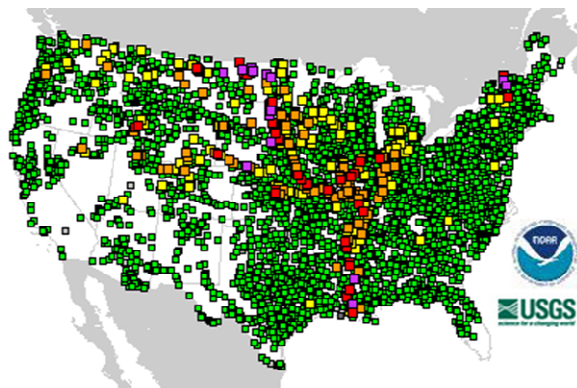

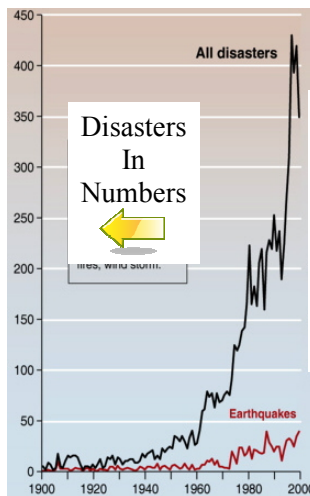
